

Minutes of the Annual General Meeting

20th May 2016 Institution of Civil Engineers, One Great George Street, London

1. Welcome and apologies

Heather Barnes, ADEPT President and chair of the AGM, welcomed those attending the meeting. Apologies were received from a number of members – see Annex 2.

2. Minutes of last Annual General Meeting (see here)

4. Honorary Secretary & Treasurer's Report (see here for more detail)

Overall, income was £51,000 below target. This is mainly due to two aspects:

- £25,000 of research funding received in 2014/15 from Ringway had also been budgeted for in 2015/16.
- Events income was £20,614 below target.

Measures to address the deficit:

- Recruit more members (15 new authorities and 5 new LEPs) and maintaining a high retention rate
- Review membership fees for 2017/18
- Introduce a corporate partner membership
- Attract sponsorship for all events
- > Reduce expenditure.

Comments include:

- Opportunities for greater income generation by securing higher attendance at the annual conference
- Welcome the publication of the authority / LEP membership maps

Resolution: the report was noted and approved.

5. Constitutional change: corporate partner membership (see here for more detail)

ADEPT is looking to establish more strategic, long-term relationships with corporate companies. With this in mind, Paper 5.1 proposed the creation of a corporate partner



membership. The proposed annual membership fee is £5,000 plus VAT. The offer, and cost, has been benchmarked against similar organisations such as CIHT. The proposal has received positive feedback from those organisations the President's Team has discussed it with.

Comments from the floor include:

- 'Access to President's Team' would need to be clearly articulated as part of the offer
- Benefits of working with the private sector
- Business will help to strengthen the voice of ADEPT with government
- Will there still be sponsorship opportunities to businesses that aren't corporate partners?
- Partnership emphasis rather than sponsorship
- Any corporate partner will need to be supportive of the ethos of ADEPT
- Governance arrangements need to be clearly defined to avoid any prejudice

Resolution: motion carried.
