He mentioned that both Ofgem and Energy Systems Catapult had released some guidance on creating LAEPs. He also referred to LAEP+, project LEO (Local Energy Oxfordshire) which is part funded by the Prospering from the Energy Revolution Fund, and the work being carried out by the Greater Manchester Combined Authority. Lynne MacDonald and Venus Tam from UKPN gave a presentation on Project CLEO (Collaborative Local Energy Optimisation). LMD informed the group that a prototype of project CLEO would be released in the summer.
